PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE :

Nazira College is one of the leading premier Higher Education institution in Assam. The College is located at Sub-division of Nazira, District Sivasagar, Assam, 19 km from Sivasagar Town, and 3 km from Simaluguri Jn. and 78 km from Jorhat air port. The Nazira College, affiliated to Dibrugarh University, Dibrugarh, was established on 16th December 1981 with a view to promoting Higher Education at Nazira and its surrounding areas. The College came under the deficit-grants in-aid system of Govt. of Assam in 1996 and under provincialization act. 2005. The College has left no stone unturned to provide quality education to students since its establishment.

The College has the capacity to enroll 1000 students in Undergraduate Programme and 150 students in Higher Secondary Programme. Skill based courses like BCA, BMC under KKHSOU, Assam; Junior Software Developer (NSQF Level 4) Under NSHM Udaan Skill Pvt. Ltd. ; PG courses in Economics, Assamese, Education, Sociology and Political Science under Directorate of Distance Education, Dibrugarh University and Political Science, Education and Assamese under KKHSOU are introduced in the college.

The College has completed 37 years of its commendable existence on 16th Dec., 2016. The college has attained a pride of place amongst the higher education institutions in upper Assam. The NAAC Academic Audit Team visited the college on 13th May, 2017 and the MHRD, Govt. of India has ranked the college among top 200 colleges of India in National Institution Ranking Framework 2017.

Our endeavor is to take higher education out of traditional contours and make it more job and value-oriented accessible to all segments of society, ensuring equity and increasing the rate of employability by establishing academia-industry linkage in line with the market demand.

FACILITIES AVAILABLE :

Smart Class room: The college has one virtual class room and ten smart class rooms with DLP Projector, White Magnetic Board, Lectern System, Portable 3D Visualize Device and Laptops.

Audio Visual Aid: Overhead LCD projectors, Green Chalk Board, White Board, Laptops and sound system are facilitated in the classroom for better teaching-learning process and also for seminars and conferences.

Computer / Internet Section: The college is equipped with well furnished computer laboratory with 30 computer-sets. The college has introduced computer courses to cater to the need of computer education in modern time. It is a self financing course afforded with a very nominal fee for duration of one year/ six months. Students & staffs can browse internet for getting information. The library has been practising Open Access and open from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM in all working days. Conference Hall: A well-furnished multipurpose conference hall is available in the college for large meetings, cultural programs etc. Besides it, there is a digital AC conference hall with a seating capacity of 50.

Hostel: The college provides comfortable, salubrious and safe lodgings to a limited number of outstation students (Girls). Boarders are looked after and taken care by the hostel warden and matrons who reside in campus and are accessible at all times. Students can apply for hostel seats immediately after getting admission.

Laboratory: The College has well-equipped laboratories in the departments of Geography, Education, Mathematics, Fashion Designing and Information Technology.

Common rooms for students: There are separate common rooms for boys and girls.

Canteen: The College is facilitated with a spacious and salubrious canteen in the college premises.

Career Guidance & Counseling Cell: The Career Guidance and Counseling Cell of the College provides a lot of information on career aspects, employment opportunities etc. It has been established with an aim to train & prepare students with soft skills required for appearing in interviews and enhance their self confidence. Career counsellors are invited time to time from different parts of the country to guide and council the students.

Anti Ragging Cell: The anti-ragging cell has been constituted in the college in 2012 as per the direction of honorable Supreme Court to prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging amongst the students. Students found indulging in such activities will be immediately expelled from the college and legal action will be taken as per honorable Supreme Court Verdict.

Sexual Harassment and Gender sensitization Cell: The sexual harassment and gender sensitization cell organizes awareness and motivational camps to create gender friendly environment.

Students Union: There is a students' union in the college and the students' representatives are democratically elected as per rules laid down in the constitution and the verdict of the Supreme Court is strictly followed in this regard. Structure of Courses of the Programmes:

The B.A. Programme offers the following components.

- (i) Compulsory Courses are Common to all students of the programme.
- (ii) Major (Honours) Courses can or may be chosen by the student. Major Course is mandatory in CBCS system in the college. Each student has to select one subject available in the college as honours subject.
- (iii) Pass (Generic) Course (any one) can or may be chosen by the student from the subject available.
- (iv) Skill Based Course is also to be selected as per University syllabi.

Academic Rules :

- A student may be allowed to change one subject of combination only within one month of the admission. He/she is to get permission from the principal by applying on a plain paper, through respective head of the department for such change.
- There is provision for reservation of seats for students belonging S.T. and S.C. categories as per Govt. rules. Preference shall be given to candidate with valid certificate issued by the competent authority.
- The guardian must be present at the time of admission.

Registration Procedure :

- The candidate shall have to register themselves to the university immediate after the admission. The information provided by the student shall be treated as final.
- In no circumstances changes from major programme to general program & Vice-Versa shall be allowed after registration.

BACHELOR OF VOCATION (B.VOC.) PROGRAMME :

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has launched a scheme on skills development based higher education as part of college/university education, leading to Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc.) Degree with multiple exits such as Diploma/Advanced Diploma under the NSQF. The B.Voc. programme is focused on providing undergraduate studies which would also incorporate specific job roles and their NOSs along with broad based general education. This would enable the graduates completing B.Voc. to make a meaningful participation in accelerating India's economy by gaining appropriate employment, becoming entrepreneurs and creating appropriate knowledge.

Subjects: Fashion Designing (FD) and Information Technology (IT)

Levels of Awards: The certification levels will lead to Diploma/Advanced Diploma/B. Voc. Degree in one or more vocational areas and will be offered under the aegis of the University. This is out-lined in the following Table.

Each of the awards shall specify within parenthesis, the Skill(s) specialization:

- B. Voc. (Fashion Designing)
- B. Voc. (Information Technology) . PGDCA(Under Dibrugarh University)

Eligibility for admission in B.Voc.: The eligibility condition for admission to B.Voc. programme shall be 10+2 or equivalent, in any stream.

Curriculum: The curriculum in each of the years of the programme would be a suitable mix of general education and skill development components.

Guidelines for credit calculations: The following formula has been used for conversion of time into credit hours.

- One Credit would mean equivalent of 15 periods of 60 minutes each, for theory, workshops/labs and tutorials;
- For internship/field work, the credit weightage for equivalent hours shall be 50% of that for lectures/workshops;
- For self-learning, based on e-content or otherwise, the credit weightage for equivalent hours of study should be 50% or less of that for lectures/workshops.

Seats available: 30 in each programme.

CURRICULUM OF HIGHER SECONDARY (10+2) COURSE :

Student has to take English & MIL (Assamese) or Alt.english as compulsory subjects and must take up minimum three elective subjects from the list given bellow. In addition to three elective subjects students may opt for a fourth subject. The students are offered following subjects:

Compulsory Subjects : English, MIL (Assamese, Alt English (In lieu of MIL)), Environmental Science

Elective Subject : Economics, Political Science, History, Education, Adv. Assamese, Sociology, Geography, Mathematics and Statistics.

Combination of Elective Subject : (For H.S. 1st Year)

The Students may select any four subjects from the combination listed below:

Combination I : Economics, Education, Geography, Political Science, Sociology, Mathematics, Statistics

Combination II : Economics, Education, Geography, Political Science, Sociology, Adv. Assamese, History

Admission Criteria :

A student who has passed the High School Leaving Certificate Examination of the SEBA or an equivalent examination of 10th standard recognized by the Board shall be eligible for admission into H.S Ist year course.

Number of seats available in the course : 150

Admission Procedure:

There is an admission committee of the college to conduct the admission process. The committee consists of all the heads of the departments and the Principal is the Chairman of the committee.

The following procedures are followed for admission:

1. The candidates are required to register themselves to take admission in the college. A Registration Form has to be submitted by each student through online by visiting college website www.naziracollege.in by paying minimum Registration fee digitally. The Registration link is available in the college website (www.naziracollege.in) w.e.f. June, 2020. .

2. The admission committee will select the Registered students students to take admission in the college purely on Merit Basis. The reservation is also followed as per Government norms.

3. The selected candidate list will be uploaded in the college website soon after the selection procedure is over. The selected students will have to fill up admission form online in the college portal and pay required admission fees digitally. At the time of filled up admission form students are requested to keep ready the following documents digitally:

- (a) Passport size Photo
- (b) Self Signature
- (c) Mark sheet and Certificate of the Last Examination
- (d) Caste Certificate
- (e) B.P.L. or Income Certificate
- (f) Anti Ragging Affidavit

Last Date Registration and Admission: Till July 31st , 2020.
(Depending upon current pandemic situation the date may be changed or modified.
The notification will be uploaded in the College Portal)

ACADEMIC RULES :

- a) A student may be allowed to change one subject of combination only within one month of the admission. He/she is to get permission from the principal by applying on a plain paper, through respective head of the department for such change.
- b) There is provision for reservation of seats for students belonging S.T. and S.C. categories as per Govt. rules. Preference shall be given to candidate with valid certificate issued by the competent authority.
- c) The guardian must be present at the time of admission.
- d) Attendance in classes is compulsory. Students who do not attend at least 70% of the classes held will be dis-collegiated and will not be allowed to appear in the examination held by University. A student attending more than 70 %, but less than 80 % classes will be treated as non-collegiate candidate and such category of students will have to pay Rs. 500/- as fine. A student failing to attend classes for 25 days at a time after starting of classes shall be forfeited his/her seat. Attendance in the practical classes is compulsory.

STUDENT'S CODE OF CONDUCT :

- a) Great emphasis is laid on discipline and character building; and students are expected to maintain a high standard of discipline. They are subject to the rules and regulations of the college.
- b) The student admitted to the college must abide by all rules and regulations as prescribed by the college authority.

EXAMINATION & EVALUATION :

For Bachelor Degree (B.A.) Programme :

- i) There shall be two Sessional Examinations and one End Semester Examination in each semester.
- ii) There shall be 20 marks for Internal Assessment & 80% marks for End Semester Examination in each course during a semester.
- iii) Student may apply for re-evaluation and re-scrutiny of the answer scripts of the End Semester Examination through proper channel.
- iv) In Internal Assessment, different tools are to be used such as Written Test, Paper Presentation, and Laboratory work, Group Discussion etc. suitable to the course. The Process of Internal Assessment is compulsory for all students.

For Higher Secondary (10+2) Programme :

- i) There will be class test, unit test and terminal examination conducted by college authority and final examination will be conducted by AHSEC.
- ii) There shall be Field study for environmental science.

For Bachelor of Vocation (B. Voc.) Programme :

- i) The assessment for the general education component done by the Dibrugarh University as per their prevailing standards and procedures.
- ii) The assessment for the skill development components necessarily focus on practical demonstrations of the skills acquired.
