'School library is the best place to grow reading habits'

Rajendra Mohan Dev Sarma

A book can be one's best friend for life. A human friend can mislead us, but a book will never.



We must read books, not only for entertainment but also for learning. The habit of reading

must be inculcated in childhood. As Francis Bacon says, "Reading maketh a full man, conference a ready man and writing an exact man."

School is the best time to grow this habit. Proper use of the resources of a school library can play a pivotal ro-

le in enhancing career prospects. Reading for an extra hour in the library on a daily basis is helpful in studies. A library is a storehouse of information and knowledge, where we find the ideals of the world's great philosophers, thinkers and leaders, through which we can communicate with them.

Books are like treasure troves — disseminating information and leading to knowledge and wisdom.

How to choose a book is, however, a dilemma for all. The ideal library is the one which covers a variety of ideas, thoughts and subjects. A student can also consult e-books from the National Digital Library of India

(NDLI) — a project of the Union ministry of human resource development. As Bacon had also said, "Some books are to be tasted, others to be swallowed, and some few to be chewed and digested."

The status of libraries in schools of our country are, however, not up to the required mark. Stakeholders must provide adequate financial assistance to schools to grow their libraries, besides appointing qualified librarians, conducting library orientation programmes, book exhibitions and book talks.


