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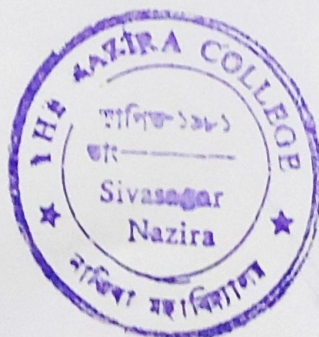

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Brief Report of various Program/activities conducted and participated by the Women cell of Nazira College during last five Years(i.e. 1915 to 1920)

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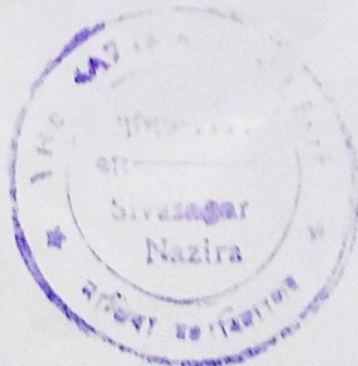


